

## Vaccination against coronavirus

You can protect yourself from coronavirus by getting a vaccine. It will prevent you from getting seriously ill from the disease. Ultimately you will also be protecting your family, friends and the people around you.

If more people get the vaccination, fewer people will become ill.

If you get vaccinated, the risk of you then getting seriously ill from coronavirus is extremely small.



Whether you get vaccinated or not is your own decision. No one is obliged to get vaccinated.

The vaccination is free of charge.

Everyone is entitled to a vaccination, even if you do not have a Citizen Service Number (BSN).



The vaccine rules in the Netherlands are extremely strict. The vaccines have been thoroughly tested on thousands of people. The risk of serious side effects is extremely small.



The vaccine is administered in your upper arm. You will be given the Janssen vaccination. This vaccine is effective after just one dose.



A lot of information is available about the vaccines. Not all that information is true. Make sure you consult reliable information so that you can make your own choice.



## Did you know?

- You can also be vaccinated anonymously. You do not have to give your name. If you do not have a Citizen Service Number (BSN), an anonymous BSN will be provided.
- However, you must fill in a health declaration in advance. You can do this
  anonymously. The health declaration is available in numerous languages at
  the vaccination location.
- If you are pregnant, you should make this known in advance. The Janssen vaccine is not suitable for pregnant women, but other vaccines are.
- If you have medical questions, please ask the doctor who is at the vaccination location.

## Do not be afraid, the vaccination is perfectly safe

- The police do not carry out any checks at the vaccination locations.
- You will not be arrested. There is no contact with the IND or police (either at the vaccination location or via the data system).
